Once the safe parking space is open, the community should contact the operator directly. The contact information will be shared at community meetings and via email.

Who makes up the rules for this Safe Parking lot? The Low Income Housing Institute (LIHI) is contracted to operate and oversee the day-to-day management of the site.

What oversight will be provided at the pilot site? LIHI is responsible for safety and security within the pilot site. Residents are screened for entry and must follow program rules to stay. Residents who are deemed ineligible for continued participation will not be allowed to return to pilot site.

What happens if there is a problem at the camp? The pilot project and all its participants are committed to being good neighbors. Exemption 02

How can I help? Neighbors and businesses have generously supported other homelessness focused projects in the City through donations of hot meals and clothing. The parking pilot operator will share information at community meetings and via email about how best to get involved.
