Subject: High-Priority Site Update

Hello all,

I hope this email finds you well.

First of all, I would like to share that I have returned to work, and I want to offer a huge thank you to Bradly, Dwight, and Christine for taking on additional tasks in my absence. Thank you all for your continued work and collaboration as well.

For today, I have been asked to share the following information:

We've known since March 31st that Parks designated the following areas as high-priority sites but did not know timing of potential encampment removals. We received timing information for Rainier Playfield and Miller Park yesterday afternoon.

Location	Site-Clear Goal	MDAR Removal if Necessary
Rainier Playfield	April 7	MDAR notice to be posted on April 7 for removal on April 9
Miller Park	April 13	MDAR notice to be posted on April 14 for removal on April 16
Gillman Park	Coming soon, date not determined.	Coming soon, date not determined.
University Playfield	Coming soon, date not determined.	Coming soon, date not determined.

From now thru April 9 and April 16 (respectively) Rainier Playfield and Miller Park will be our only active high-priority sites. As a reminder, high-priority sites are identified by City departments as needing to be encampment-free. The HOPE Team advocates for the length of pre-outreach based on conversations with providers as well as our own knowledge of the sites, however we are not the final decision-makers on timing.

Our role as HOPE and outreach providers is to work together to help folks at high-priority sites to move indoors or to help them relocate to another outdoor location of their choosing. High-priority sites require several things:

- HOPE Team coordination and support
- Outreach provider engagement and participation in coordinated efforts, including on the morning of an MDAR removal if one becomes necessary
- Daily data reports to HOPE Team including:
 - By-name offers of shelter, by day
 - Shelter assessments done for each individual on site
 - Other data needs as required by City departments or the Mayor's Office
- HOPE prioritization of recommendations coming from high-priority sites
