Appellant Compassion Seattle has filed an emergency motion to stay the order appealed, which declares that proposed amendment 29 to the City of Seattle charter (CA 29) “exceeds the scope of the initiative power, is invalid, null, and void.” The order also enjoins King County and King County Auditor Julie Wise “from placing CA 29 on the November 2021 general election ballot (or subsequent election ballots), tabulating votes on CA 29, and otherwise furthering an election on CA 29.”
