

# Emergency Housing Voucher - Provider Survey

Dear Provider,

The King County public housing authorities recently received allocations of new Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) to serve people who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness, and these vouchers can also be used for moving on from permanent supportive housing. EHV are essentially similar to section 8/housing choice vouchers, and also have some financial assistance for move-in costs and housing navigation, but do not fund on-going case management or supportive services.

Your organization has been identified as a potential partner for voucher allocation through the Provider Reverse Matching Pathway and/or the DV System Pathway. This survey seeks information from you about your agency's case management capacity to support EHV and your agency's leadership demographics so that we can better understand your organization. We ask that you complete this survey to quickly summarize the likely number of households who your agency would support using EHV through navigation into placement and one year afterwards supporting housing stability.

People who are subject to lifetime sex offender registration or who have been convicted of the manufacture of methamphetamine in federally assisted housing are NOT eligible for EHV, nor are households comprised entirely people without documentation of legal residency status.
